

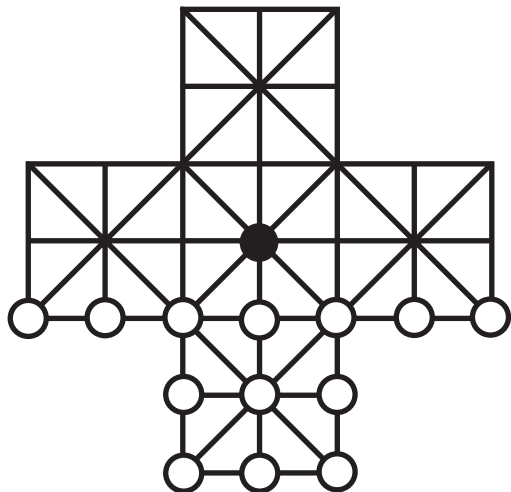
# Fox and Geese

## Introduction:

"Fox and Geese" is a traditional strategy game that originated in Iceland. Two players of any age can play. You'll need to print out the game board and cut out the 14 game pieces.

## Instructions:

First, set up the board as shown here. (The white discs represent geese; the black is the fox.)



Choose one person to be the fox. The other will be the geese. The object is for the fox to remove as many of the geese as possible to keep them from capturing him. The goal of the geese is to trap the fox so that he cannot move.

Players take turns moving their pieces. Pieces can be moved in any direction along a line to the next vacant point. The fox removes geese by jumping over them to a vacant point. The goose is then removed from the board. The geese try to trap the fox by surrounding him so that he cannot move in any direction.

If the geese manage to capture the fox, that player wins! If the fox manages to remove enough geese to make himself impossible to capture, that player wins!
