

## **Project: Bron's 60<sup>th</sup> Birthday**

### **The memories from this birthday will last for generations!**

A professional portrait of my mum was taken in 1964 for her 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. 42 Years later it became the focus for her 60<sup>th</sup> birthday

My Epson RX510 captures the spirit of the occasion.

#### **Step 1: SCAN**

The original photo size was 5x8cm.

Using my Epson RX510 I scanned the photo and stored the image using the software for Epson Smart Panel. The Epson software worked seamlessly with my PC.

#### **Step 2: PRINT**

I used my Epson RX510 to print the invitations. I used genuine Epson inks to reprint the photos onto the Epson Premium Glossy Photo Paper. I used Epson Photo Project view and Create to reprint the photos to 3.81x3.81. These were auto cropped to size. The cut and glued to the invites.

I made table decorations for each candelabra with the image printed onto Epson Premium Glossy Photo Paper.

I re-sized the photo to A4 size using Epson Photo Project-View and Create. The image was printed on Epson Premium Glossy Photo Paper and Epson genuine inks. The photo lost none of its sharpness. The A4 photo was inserted into a memory board which guests signed during the night.

#### **Step 3: T-SHIRTS**

For each grandchild I made a T-shirt to wear. I used Epson Photo Project to print the image onto Epson Iron-On Cool Peel Transfer Paper. Even after the party my children have worn their T-shirt and the transfers have lost none of their colour or quality since they were first worn.
